The Heart of St. John Berchmans

150 years ago, on Dec. 14, 1866, Blessed John Berchmans appeared to a gravely ill novice, Mary Wilson, and she was instantaneously and completely cured by his intercession, in our state of LA. This was the Vatican-approved miracle needed for Berchmans to be canonized. In commemoration of this anniversary, the Heart of St. John Berchmans will be at the Cathedral of St. John Berchmans from December 8-18. This is the first time the Heart has ever traveled outside of its homeland, modern day Belgium, since his death 395 years ago.

During the heart's stay at the Cathedral, there are scheduled times for Masses in the presence of the Heart and opportunities for veneration of the Heart as well as Guest Speakers and an exhibit of items related to the life and miracle of St. John Berchmans. Pope Francis is aware of "this significant ecclesial event" taking place in our diocese. The Pope's prayer for us is the "by the intercession and example of St. John Berchmans, the hearts of many will be converted to a deeper love of the Lord Jesus and a fervent desire to conform their lives to his holy will."
