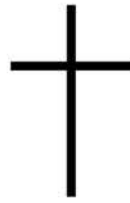

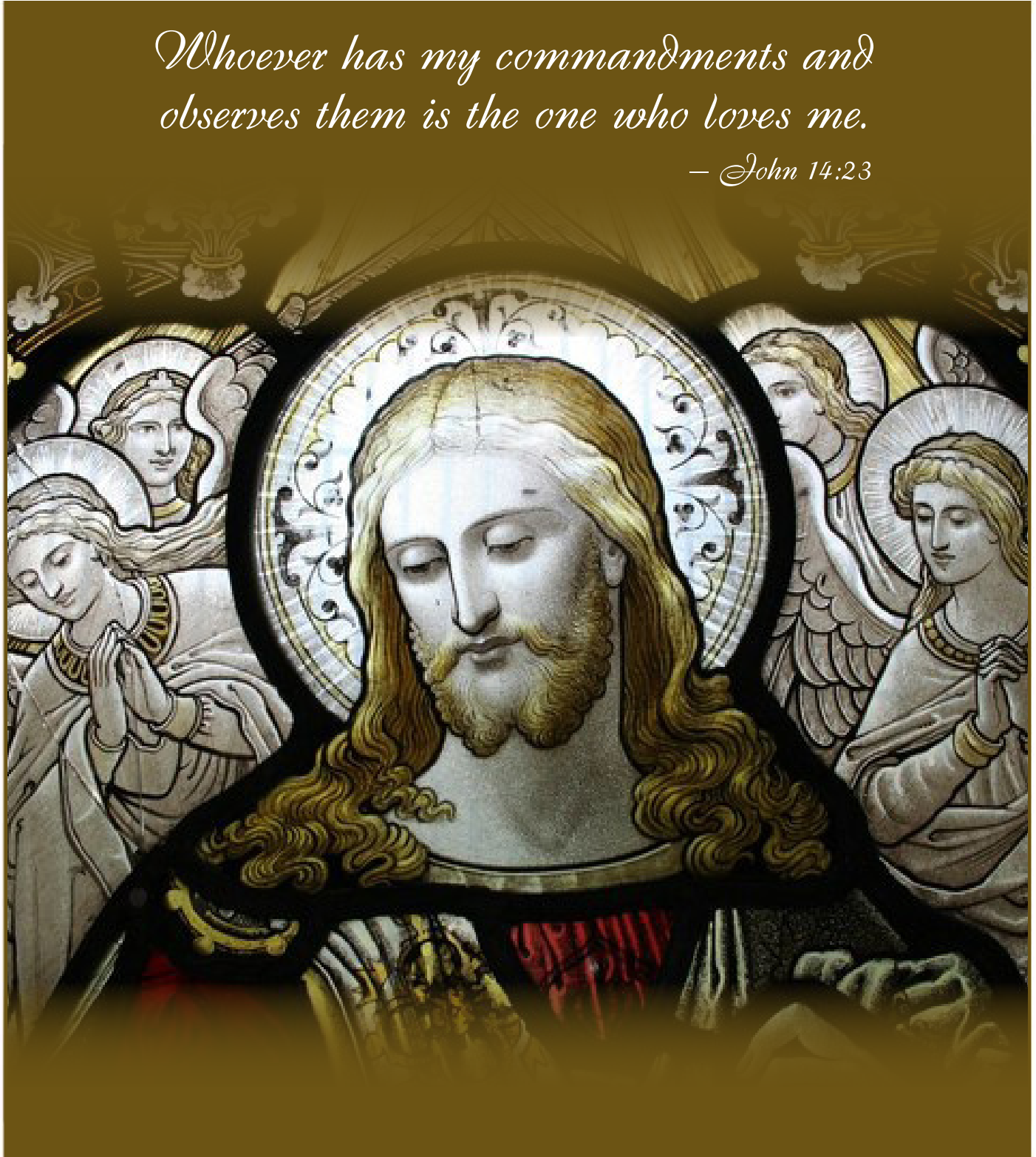

## Mother's Day & Sacraments

## Faith Comes Alive

Dear Friends:

This Sunday is one of those rare and beautiful moments in our JGS parish life when many graces converge at once.

We celebrate Mother's Day, giving thanks for the women who gave us life, who nurtured us, who prayed for us—often long before we knew how to pray for ourselves. We also celebrate a milestone for our children: our second graders receiving their First Holy Communion, and our eighth graders being sealed with the gift of the Holy Spirit in Confirmation as we welcome our Bishop among us.

It is a full church, a joyful church, a grateful church. And the Scriptures this Sunday help us understand exactly what is happening. In the Gospel for this Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord, Jesus says something very simple but very profound:

"If you love me, you will keep my commandments." Love and obedience are not opposites. They are two sides of the same reality.

**Love is not merely a feeling. Love is a choice. Love is a decision. Love is a way of life.**

That is what our children are learning.

When our second graders come forward to receive the Eucharist for the first time, they are not simply participating in a ceremony. They are entering into a relationship. They are saying, in their own childlike way: "Jesus, I love you. I want to stay close to you."

And when our eighth graders are confirmed, they are not graduating from religious education. They are being strengthened for mission. The Holy Spirit—whom Jesus calls the Advocate—comes to dwell within them, to guide them, to strengthen them, and to help them live their faith with courage.

The Acts of the Apostles tells us that when Peter and John laid hands on the baptized believers, they received the Holy Spirit. **Something real happened.** Not symbolic. Not imaginary. Real grace. Real power. Real presence.

The same thing happens here.

This is why the Church calls the sacraments performative. They do what they say. When the priest says, "This is my Body," bread becomes the Body of Christ. When the bishop lays hands on a young person, the Holy Spirit is truly given.

And that brings us back to Mother's Day.

Long before these children received their sacraments, their mothers—and fathers, grandparents, and families—were already teaching them the most important lesson of all: how to love, how to pray, how to trust God.

Faith is usually handed on quietly, patiently, faithfully—at kitchen tables, in bedtime prayers, in carpools, in small daily sacrifices that no one sees but God.

So this Sunday, as we gather together, we give thanks for many gifts at once: For mothers who love. For children who are growing in faith. For the Holy Spirit who lives within us. And for the Church that walks with us every step of the way.

It is a busy Sunday.

But more importantly, it is a holy Sunday. Because in all these moments—Mother's Day, First Communion, Confirmation—we see the same truth:

God is not far away.  
God is with us.  
And God is within us.
