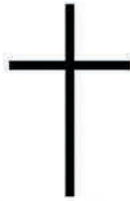

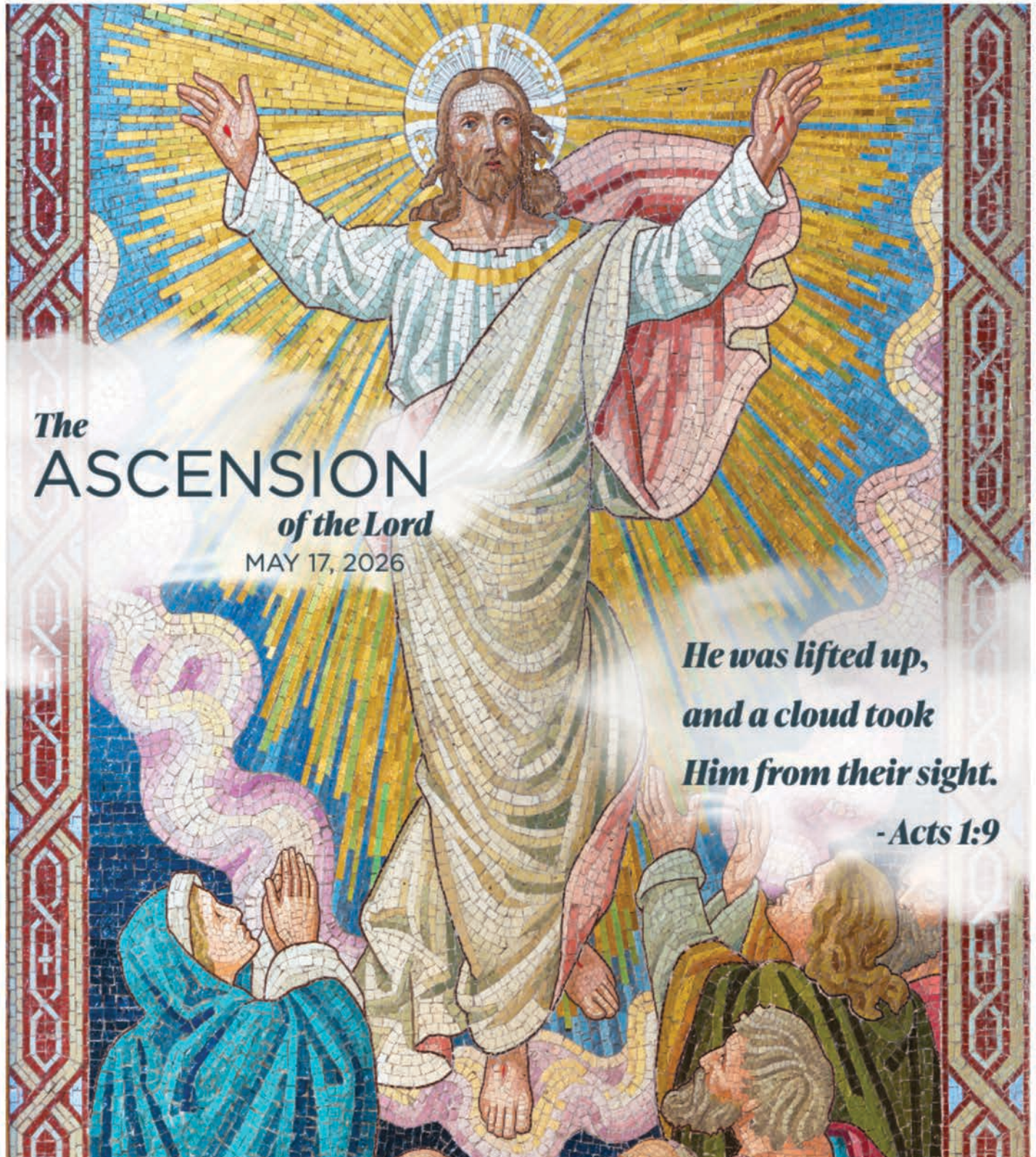

Welcome

The Mission Continues

Formed for Faith

Dear Friends:

Over the past two weeks, we have witnessed something beautiful here in our parish and in our Catholic schools. We celebrated First Holy Communion for our second graders, Confirmation for our eighth graders with the bishop, and Graduation Masses for our students at both Jesus the Good Shepherd School and St. Frederick High School. And now, in just a few days, our younger students will close the books on another school year and begin their summer break.

That is a lot of milestones in a short span of time. But the readings for this Sunday remind us that all these moments—sacraments, graduations, endings, and beginnings—are not isolated events. They are part of one great mission.

In the Gospel, Jesus speaks words that echo across every classroom, every church, and every generation: “All power in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations... and behold, I am with you always, until the end of the age.”

Notice the order. First, Jesus declares His authority. Then He gives a mission. And finally, He makes a promise. That promise matters—especially at times of transition.

For our children who received their First Holy Communion, the mission has just begun. They have met Jesus in the Eucharist, not as an idea, but as a Person who is truly present. For our newly confirmed young men and women, the Holy Spirit has strengthened them to live their faith publicly and courageously. For our graduates stepping into a new chapter, whether moving on to high school or preparing to leave it behind, the Lord’s words remain the same: I am with you.

The second reading from Saint Paul gives us a beautiful prayer: that “the eyes of your hearts may be enlightened.” That is what Catholic education, Catholic families, and our parish community are all about—helping our children see clearly. Not just to succeed academically, but to recognize truth, to seek goodness, and to know Christ.

As this school year draws to a close, it is worth remembering that education in the Catholic tradition is never only about information. It is about formation. It is about shaping minds and hearts to live in the real world—the world in which Christ is Lord.

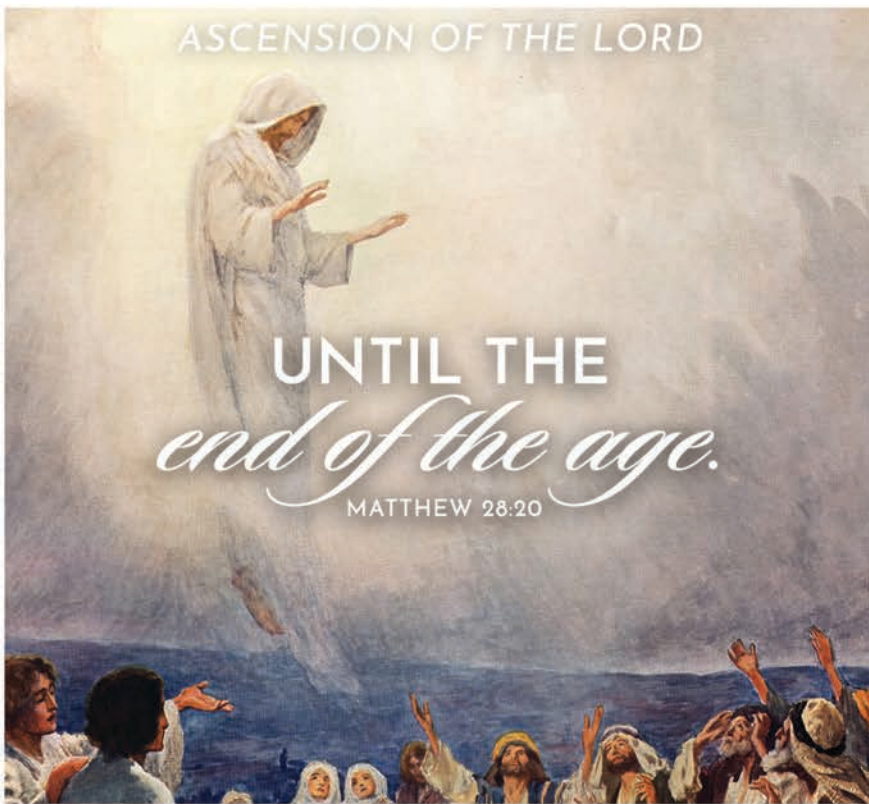
So as we celebrate these milestones and approach the final day of school, let us give thanks—for our teachers, our parents, our students, and all who have worked so hard throughout the year.

And let us pray for our young people in a special way this summer: that they may grow not only in knowledge, but in faith, not only in strength, but in wisdom, and not only in independence, but in their friendship with Jesus Christ.

Because the mission continues. And the promise remains: “I am with you always.”

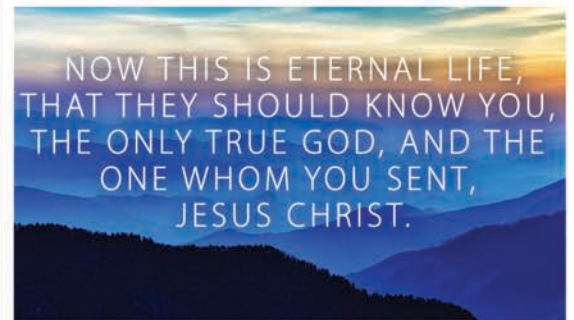

Public Notice – Action Required

Sexual Abuse Claims in the Diocese of Alexandria Bankruptcy

Regardless of how old you are today or when the sexual abuse occurred, you need to file your claim so that it is received by June 8, 2026.

The Diocese of Alexandria ("Diocese" or "Debtor") has filed bankruptcy to restructure its nonprofit organization and pay Putative Abuse Survivors. Please read this notice carefully as it may impact your rights against the Diocese and provides information about the case, *In re: Diocese of Alexandria*, Case No. 25-31257 (Bankr. W.D. La.). Who Should File a Putative Abuse Survivor Claim?

Anyone who alleges they were abused and believes the Diocese, or persons affiliated with the Diocese, may be responsible for the abuse must file a claim. This includes abuse in connection with any entity or activity associated with the Diocese, including schools, orphanages, parishes, or Catholic Charities. A list of such entities associated with the Diocese is available on the website or by calling the toll-free number listed below. If you have an abuse claim against any entity on that list, you may have a claim against the Diocese. Only the Diocese is in bankruptcy. If you have a claim against any entity on that list, you must take additional legal action to preserve and pursue your rights.

When and How Should I File a Putative Abuse Survivor Claim?

You should file a claim using the Putative Abuse Survivor Proof of Claim so that it is received by June 8, 2026. If you do not file a timely Putative Abuse Survivor Claim, you may lose rights against the Diocese, including any right to compensation.

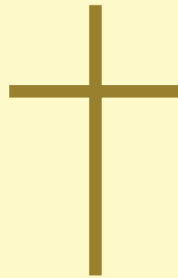
