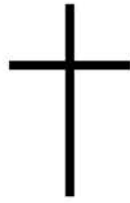

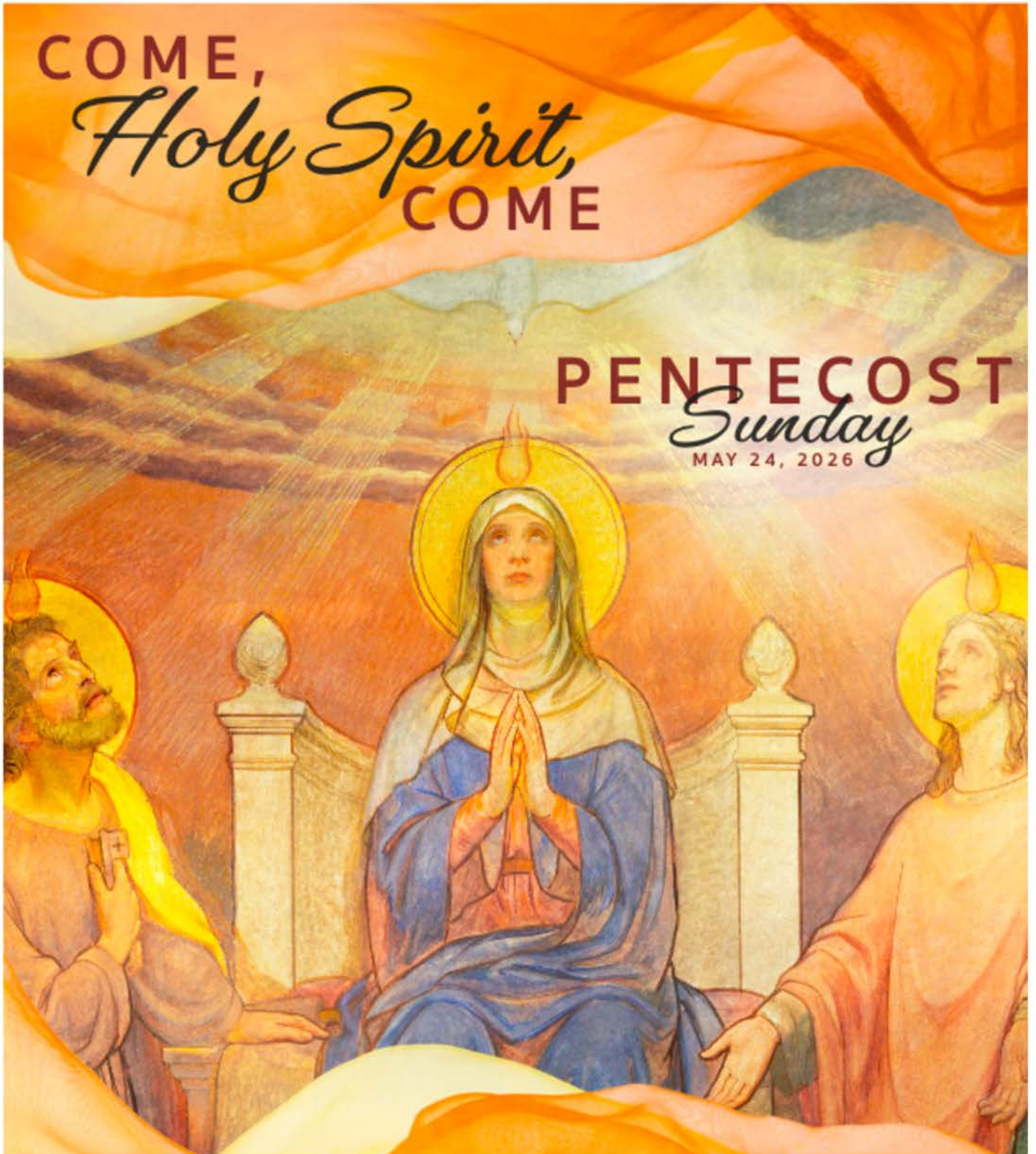

To Our Young Adults

*The Spirit is
 calling you*

Dear Friends:

This weekend, the Church celebrates Pentecost—the day the Holy Spirit came upon ordinary men and women and changed the course of history. They were not scholars or saints yet. They were unsure, a little afraid, and still figuring things out. In many ways, they were not so different from many young adults today. They were gathered in a room, wondering what came next.

And then everything changed.

A strong wind filled the house. Tongues of fire rested on each of them. They began to speak with courage, clarity, and purpose. The Holy Spirit did not remove their personalities or erase their differences. Instead, He took who they were and gave their lives direction. That is what the Holy Spirit still does.

Many young adults today carry quiet questions:

Where am I going? What am I supposed to do with my life? Where do I belong? Many are starting to consider joining the Catholic Church!

Pentecost answers those questions in a surprising way. It reminds us that life is not just about finding yourself—it is about receiving a mission. The Holy Spirit did not come simply to comfort the disciples. He came to send them.

At the end of every Mass, the Church still echoes that same moment. The final words are not simply a polite dismissal. They are a commission: Go. Your life has purpose. Your faith is meant to be lived in the world.

And here is something important to remember: the Holy Spirit works through the Church, not apart from it. The Spirit who filled the disciples at Pentecost formed them into a visible community. Faith was never meant to be a private hobby or a solitary journey. It is something lived together—through worship, friendship, service, and the sacraments.

You may be in a season of transition right now—finishing school, starting a career, moving to a new city, building relationships, or trying to make sense of the future. These years can feel uncertain. They can also be full of possibility. Pentecost reminds us that uncertainty is not a problem for God. It is often the place where He begins His greatest work.

The Holy Spirit gives gifts—talents, energy, creativity, compassion, leadership, courage. Those gifts are not given randomly. They are given for a reason: to build up the Church and to serve the world. The Church needs your voice, your questions, your faith, and your presence more than you might realize.

So here is the invitation this Pentecost, especially to

you, our young adults: Do not drift. Do not stay on the sidelines. Do not assume your faith is something for later in life. Ask the Holy Spirit to lead you now. Stay close to the sacraments. Stay connected to the community. And trust that God is already at work in your life—guiding you, strengthening you, and preparing you for more than you can yet see.

The same Spirit who filled that upper room is still moving today.
And He is calling you by name.

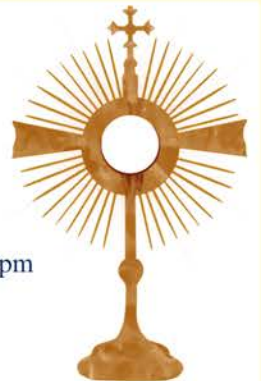
