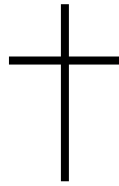

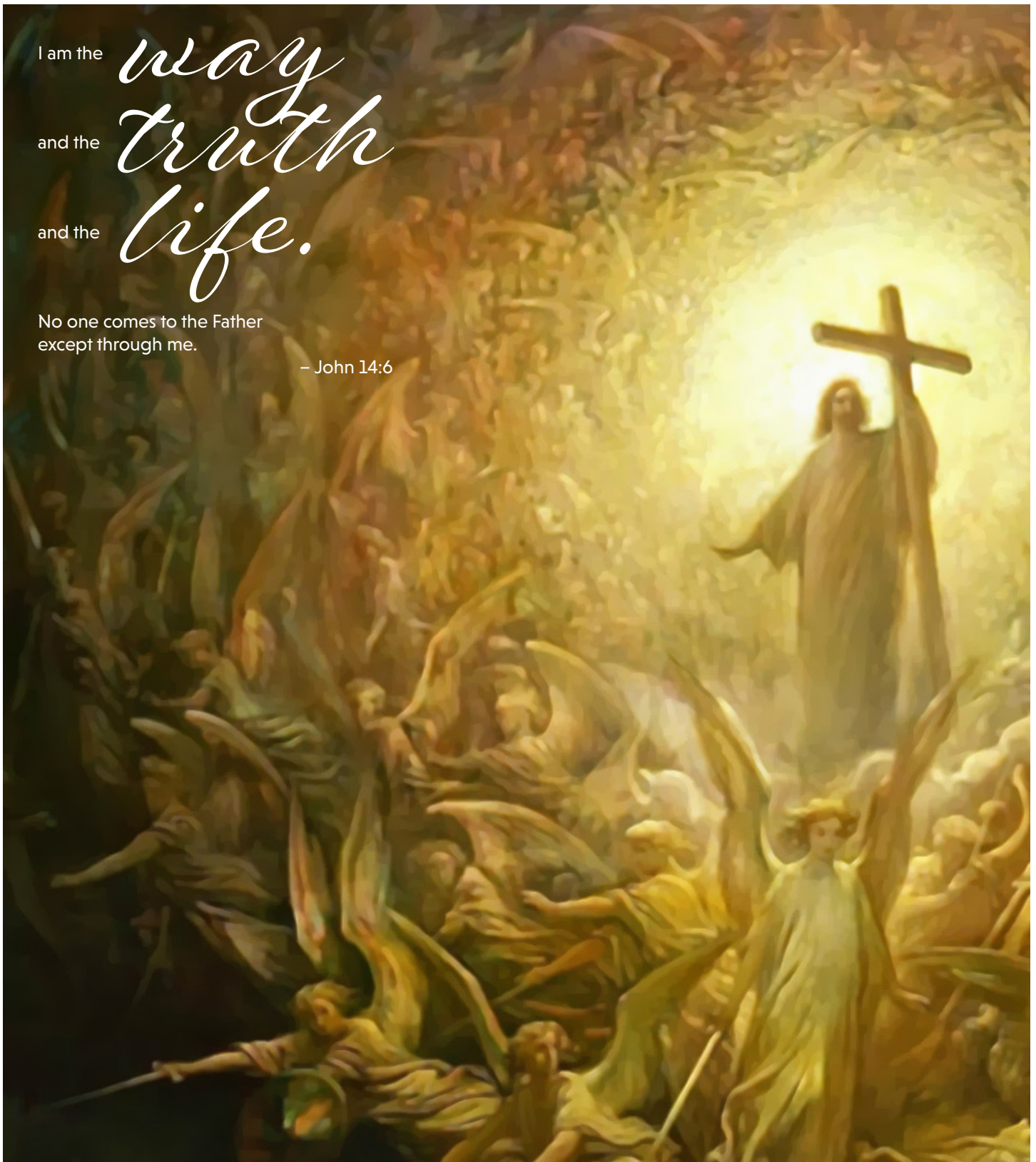

Rooted in Service

Quiet Acts Matter

Dear Friends:

Recently, our statue of St. Fiacre and its niche received some much-needed attention. The statue has been carefully cleaned, and the niche freshly stained. It looks beautiful again—simple, dignified, and welcoming.

Many thanks go to parishioners for their generosity and initiative—especially Mark Nix, who helped care for the statue itself, and Edward Curry, who so faithfully tended to what we might call St. Fiacre's "house." Their quiet work reminds us that stewardship is often expressed not in grand gestures, but in loving attention to small things.

When this garden area was first created, it was Joe and Ann Ledoux who saw to the planting of the garden and the placement of the statue of St. Fiacre, the patron saint of gardeners. Our statue shows him holding a plant in one hand and a shovel in the other—an image that beautifully captures the rhythm of his life: prayer and work, contemplation and service.

St. Fiacre was born in Ireland around the year 600. He was raised in a monastery, where he learned not only the life of prayer but also the practical skills of planting, growing, and caring for the earth. Eventually he sought a quiet life as a hermit, longing for solitude and silence. Yet God had other plans.

People began to seek him out—first a few, then many—drawn by his kindness, wisdom, and reputation for healing. What began as a simple garden became a refuge for travelers, the sick, and those searching for peace. Though he desired solitude, St. Fiacre discovered that holiness often means allowing God to use our gifts for the good of others.

That is why he became known as the patron saint of gardeners. Not only because he cultivated the soil, but because he cultivated souls.

There is something fitting about having St. Fiacre watching over this garden. A garden requires patience. It requires care. It requires tending day after day, often without immediate results. The same is true of our spiritual lives, our families, and our parish community.

Every weed pulled, every plant watered, every small act of care matters.

In the end, St. Fiacre teaches us a simple lesson: Holiness grows slowly—but it grows surely—when we faithfully tend what God has placed in our hands. Thank you to everyone who continues to care for the beauty of our parish grounds. Your work is seen, appreciated, and—like a well-tended garden—bears fruit in ways we may never fully realize.

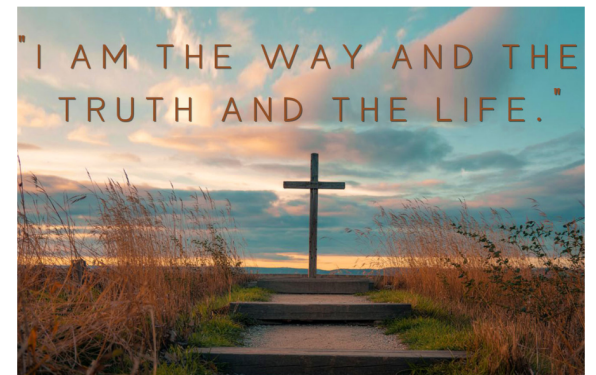

Public Notice – Action Required

Sexual Abuse Claims in the Diocese of Alexandria Bankruptcy

Regardless of how old you are today or when the sexual abuse occurred, you need to file your claim so that it is received by June 8, 2026.

The Diocese of Alexandria ("Diocese" or "Debtor") has filed bankruptcy to restructure its nonprofit organization and pay Putative Abuse Survivors. Please read this notice carefully as it may impact your rights against the Diocese and provides information about the case, *In re: Diocese of Alexandria*, Case No. 25-31257 (Bankr. W.D. La.). This notice is a short summary. For more detail, go to <https://cases.stretto.com/diocesefalexandria> or call (855) 655-5795.

Who Should File a Putative Abuse Survivor Claim?

Anyone who alleges they were abused and believes the Diocese, or persons affiliated with the Diocese, may be responsible for the abuse must file a claim. This includes abuse in connection with any entity or activity associated with the Diocese, including schools, orphanages, parishes, or Catholic Charities. A list of such entities associated with the Diocese is available on the website or by calling the toll-free number listed below. If you have an abuse claim against any entity on that list, you may have a claim against the Diocese. Only the Diocese is in bankruptcy. If you have a claim against any entity on that list, you must take additional legal action to preserve and pursue your rights.

When and How Should I File a Putative Abuse Survivor Claim?

You should file a claim using the Putative Abuse Survivor Proof of Claim so that it is received by June 8, 2026. If you do not file a timely Putative Abuse Survivor Claim, you may lose rights against the Diocese, including any right to compensation.

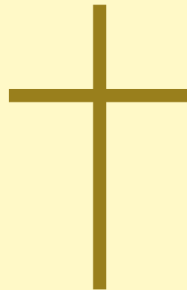
