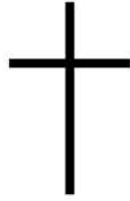

## The Trinity

## You Were Made for Relationship

Dear Friends:

One of the most beautiful—and most misunderstood—truths of our faith is the Holy Trinity. We believe in one God... but not a solitary God. We believe in a God who is Father, Son, and Holy Spirit—a communion of love, a relationship from all eternity.

And that matters more than we sometimes realize, especially for our young people. Because if God were alone, distant, or impersonal, then life would ultimately be about rules, performance, or survival. But the Trinity tells us something very different: at the center of the universe is not power, not success, not achievement—but love.

As St. John tells us so simply, “God is love.” Love requires relationship. Love requires giving. Love requires others. That is why families matter. That is why friendships matter. That is why the Church matters. And that is why the life of our parish—especially the life of our young people—is so important.

**In the coming weeks, we will see that life in action right here among us.** We will be training new altar servers—young men and women who step forward to serve at the altar, to learn responsibility, reverence, and leadership. They may begin by learning where to stand, when to ring a bell, or how to carry a candle. But what they are really learning is something deeper: how to be close to the Lord and how to serve others.

Soon after the Fourth of July, our parish will once again be filled with energy as we host Vacation Bible School. For one full week, our classrooms and hallways will echo with prayer, laughter, and discovery. It is one of the most joyful signs of a living parish—children learning that faith is not just something we talk about, but something we live.

Moments like these do not happen on their own. They happen because faithful men and women step forward and give their time, their patience, and their love. I want to express heartfelt gratitude to our catechists who have taught our children and youth this past year. Week after week, often quietly and without recognition, they helped plant seeds of faith that will bear fruit for years to come.

I am equally grateful to those who have already said “yes” to teaching in the coming year. Your willingness to serve is a gift not only to our parish, but to every child and family who will walk through our doors.

And to all who are helping with youth activities this summer—whether assisting with Vacation Bible School, supporting altar server training, chaperoning events, preparing materials, or simply showing up with encouragement—thank you. You are living witnesses to what the Trinity looks like in daily life: people working together, sharing gifts, and building something greater than themselves.

In the Gospel this Sunday, we hear one of the most familiar lines in all of Scripture: “**God so loved the world that he gave his only Son.**” Notice that word—gave. Love gives. Love sacrifices. Love reaches outward. That is the heart of the Trinity, and it is meant to become the heart of our parish.

So as we enter these summer weeks, let us continue to support our young people, encourage those who serve them, and give thanks to God for the many hands and hearts that make our parish family strong.

May the love of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit guide our youth, bless our volunteers, and shape the future of our parish for generations to come.

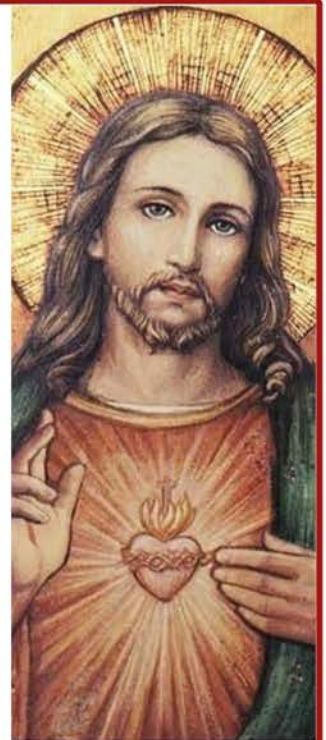
